

Format Requirements: Tree Preservation and Protection Plans

Title Blocks

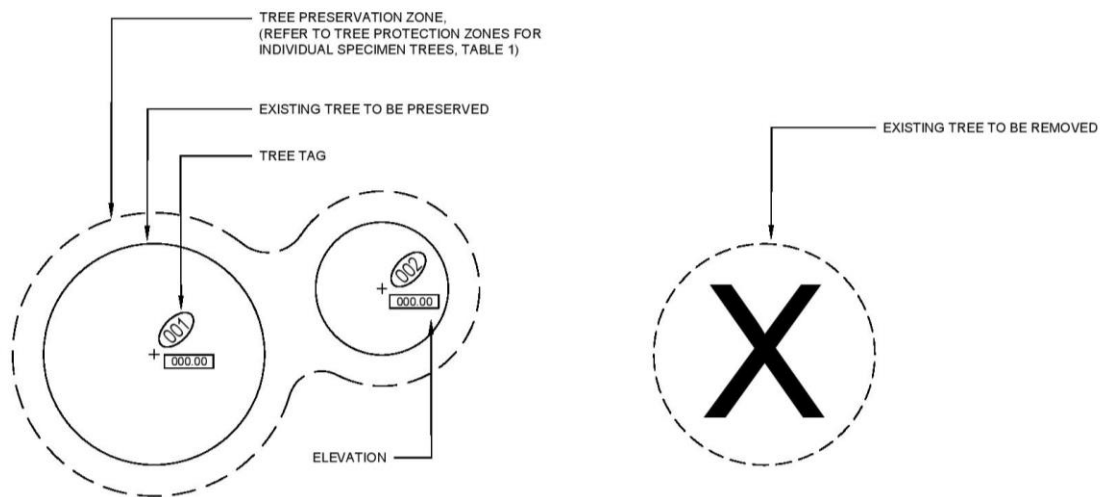
- Property Owner Information: Name, address, phone number, and email;
- Applicant Information (if different than owner): Name, address, phone number, and email;
- Consultant Information: Company name, address, project reference name/number, contact information (including name, phone number and e-mail address) and professional certification information (OALA stamp and signature, ISA number, etc.);
- Development application file number;
- Submission date, revision number, and drawing author;
- Plans will be provided in metric scale and in the same scale as any other drawings submitted with the same application;
- Key map;
- North arrow; and
- Comprehensive legend that clearly identifies symbols, line types and weights used on the plan.

Graphics

- Trees to be preserved and protected will be illustrated with solid lines and tree canopies that graphically correspond to actual canopy sizes identified in the tree inventory;
- Trees to be removed will be illustrated with dashed lines and an “X” overlaid;
- TPZ will be illustrated with dashed lines surrounding the protected tree(s);
- Property lines will be dimensioned;

- Limit of development, site disturbance, construction, or site alteration will be illustrated;
- The context of the surrounding properties will be illustrated, including adjacent properties, building setbacks, and all adjacent trees within 6.0 metres of the property line, or as otherwise required; and
- Jurisdictional limits of regulated areas will be illustrated, including buffer areas and / or setbacks.
