

# Notice of Passing of Heritage Designation By-law 8194-25 to Designate a Property of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest under the Provisions of Part IV, Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990 (Mayfield House)

**Take notice that the Council of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby Passed By-law 8194-25 on May 26, 2025, to designate lands municipally known as 780 Garden Street (Mayfield House), in the Town of Whitby, in the Regional Municipality of Durham, Ontario, as a property of Cultural Heritage Value or Interest under Part IV, S.29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O 1990.**

## **Description of Property:**

**Mayfield House (aka John Thomson House)** generally located at the northwest corner of Garden Street and Manning Road, on a portion of the property currently municipally known as 780 Garden Street, Town of Whitby, Ontario and legally described as Part of Block 1, Plan 40M-2785, designated as Parts 1 and 2, Plan 40R-32970.

As required under S.29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act*, the Town of Whitby is hereby providing notice of its decision to the property owner and the Ontario Heritage Trust.

## **Appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT):**

**TAKE NOTICE** that an appeal of the Designation By-law for the Property by those persons permitted to appeal under Section 29 of the *Ontario Heritage Act* may be made by submitting a Notice of Appeal with the OLT and Town Clerk of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby by 4:30 p.m. on or before July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2025 (within 30 days of this notice). A Notice of Appeal must set out the reasons for the objection to the Designation By-law. If you wish to appeal to the Ontario Land Tribunal (OLT), please see below for options to file a notice of appeal. The filing of an appeal, either electronically through the OLT e-file service, by email, or in-person after 4:30 p.m. on the date noted above will be deemed to have been received the next business day.

Appeals may be submitted by filing a notice of appeal with the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby and making online payment of the applicable appeal fee via the OLT e-file service. First-time users will need to register for a My Ontario Account at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/e-file-service/> and will select 'Whitby (Town): Clerk' as the Approval Authority for the appeal submission.

If the e-file portal is down, appeals may be submitted to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby by email to [clerk@whitby.ca](mailto:clerk@whitby.ca) using the appropriate OLT forms found at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/about-olt>. Your notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal.

Alternatively, appeals may be filed by mail to the Clerk of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby, 575 Rossland Road East, Whitby, ON L1N 2M8 using the appropriate OLT forms found at <https://olt.gov.on.ca/about-olt>. Your notice of appeal must set out the reasons for the appeal.
