

Using the area below as a guideline, please indicate the location of the driveway on the property, the house and the proposed swimming pool. Please indicate the distance from the water's edge of the pool to the fence (in all directions). The minimum setback between the water's edge and the fence is 1 metre. Also, please be sure to indicate the location of any gate(s) and the type of fence (i.e. chain link, board fencing or wrought iron) on each side of the pool enclosure.

- Permit Fee in the amount of \$463.50 made payable to the Town of Whitby. (In case of permit application cancellation by the applicant, only 40% of the permit fee will be refunded).
- Deposits (if applicable):
 - \$1,582.00 for curb and boulevard
 - \$463.30 for boulevard access only (this is only applicable if there is no curb)
 - \$1,525.50 for sidewalk
 - \$2,361.70 for access through a Town fence
- Payments:
 - In person: payment can be made at 3050 Garden Street, Unit 102, by debit, cash or cheque.
 - By mail: the completed application and cheque(s) to Enforcement Services, 3050 Garden Street, Unit 102, Whitby, ON L1R 2G7.



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Additional Information:

• If your subdivision is not assumed by the Town, an approval letter, as well as proof that deposits are collected from the developer, must be provided with your pool enclosure permit submission.

- Should your property back on to or reside near a greenspace, additional approvals from
 Central Lake Ontario Conservation Authority (CLOCA) may be required. Confirmation that zoning
 would permit a pool on your property without a minor variance will need to be obtain and provided
 to CLOCA. Zoning information can be obtained by contacting our planning department at
 905.430.4306 or planning@whitby.ca. Please contact CLOCA for additional information by calling
 905.579.0411 or mail@cloca.com. You will be required to submit a letter of approval from CLOCA
 along with your pool enclosure permit submission.
- Should you require access through a Town easement or park, please communicate this with our
 office well in advance of construction start date. This may require additional approvals and
 insurances to be collected which can take time to collect. Please note that approval for accessing
 through a Town easement or park is not always granted. It is recommended to plan alternate
 routes for construction access if these permissions are denied.
- A Road Occupancy Permit may be required if accessing a yard from a side street or if items for construction will be stored on the boulevard or road. Please contact the Town of Whitby Public Works Department for more information at 905.668.3437.
- If you have a septic system, approval from the Region of Durham is required prior to beginning construction of the swimming pool. Please contact the Region of Durham at 905.668.7711.
- It is the responsibility of the owner/applicant to inquiry if any conditions are present on the property, such as regulation stipulated through a site plan that may impact the installation of a pool. For example, a groundwater infiltration trench or an easement. No part of the swimming pool may be located within the easement. - If you will be constructing a deck or accessory building, a building permit may be required. For
