
## Notice of Intention to Remove a Holding (H) Symbol

The Committee of the Whole of The Corporation of the Town of Whitby will consider removal of a Holding (H) symbol from By-law 1784, as amended, in accordance with the Planning Act R.S.O. 1990, to amend Zoning By-law 1784 to lift the Holding Symbol (H) from the existing Zoning Category to permit the proposed mixed-use development at 380 Taunton Rd W.

Pursuant to the provisions of the *Planning Act*, this is not a public meeting, and rights of appeal are limited to the applicant. Notice has been given in accordance with the *Planning Act* to those individuals within the land affected by the application and those individuals and agencies who requested through the Town Clerk further notice of meetings related to the lifting of the Holding (H) symbol.
