## BY-LAW NO. 5869-06

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 4394-99 - THE FENCING BY-LAW

WHEREAS, Section 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, chapter 25, as amended, provides that a municipality may pass by-laws respecting fences;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby has passed By-law No. 4394-99 to, among other things, prescribe the height and description of lawful fences;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby considers it desirable to amend By-law No. 4394-99 as it relates to the recognition of a hedge as a fence;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Whitby enacts as follows:

- 1. Section 1(d) of By-law No. 4394-99 is repealed and the following substituted:
  - (d) "fence" means any structure constructed of posts, boards, palings, rails, wire, masonry or other similar materials or any combination thereof used to define a property boundary or to enclose or partially enclose any outdoor area.
- 2. Section 1(f) of By-law No. 4394-99 is repealed.
- 3. This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing.
