





# **Blue Box Weekly Collection**

- Containers go in one blue box and papers go in the other blue box. Fold boxes flat, then tie and bundle the same size as your blue box. Place next to or on top of your blue box.

# **Green Bin Weekly Collection**


- There is **no limit to the number of Green Bins** set out for collection each week. Additional bins can be purchased from the Region of Durham at **durham.ca/NewBins** or by calling 311 (within Regional limits).
- The maximum weight per green bin is 20 kg (44 lb).
- Use only certified compostable bags (with logo) or a paper based liner.
- All material must be bagged, with the exception of fiber egg cartons and drink trays. Loose organics will not be collected.
- Did you know? Pet waste, pet litter, diapers, menstrual and incontinence products is now accepted in your weekly green bin.





## Leaf and Yard Waste (April to December)

- Limit of 16 items per collection (limit does not apply for the bagged leaves during October and November).
- Maximum weight per container, bag or bundle is 20 kg (44 lb).
- Acceptable items include bundled brush and branches, leaves, Christmas tree trimmings, pumpkins, gourds, corn stalks, fallen fruit, plant and garden waste. No grass clippings or milled lumber.
- Use kraft paper bags or an approved Yard Waste Receptacle (YWR). A YWR is a rigid open-top container with two handles, and a maximum height of 90 cm (36 in) and a width of 66 cm (26 in). No plastic bags.



Securely tie branches and brush in bundles using natural fiber twine up to 1 m (3.2 ft) in length and 0.7 m (2.5 ft) in width. Individual branches must not exceed 10 cm (4 in) in diameter.





#### **Household Hazardous Waste**

Residents can take their Household Hazardous Waste Items (HHW) to one of the Regional Waste Management Facilities free of charge. Learn more at durham.ca/WMF or call 311 (within Regional limits) for a list of items and locations.



# **Residual Waste Every Second Week Collection**

- Maximum of 4 garbage bags every other week is allowed.
- Bags must be no larger than 66 by 90 cm (26 by 36 in) at the time of purchase and weight must not exceed 20 kg (44 lb).
- Waste in garbage cans or returnable containers will not be collected.
- Collection point place garbage and green bin side by side at the end of your driveway. Do not place waste behind or on top of snowbanks.
- Bags that break when lifted will not be collected.
- Box and label your broken glass and place beside your garbage bag.
- Garbage bags will not be collected if contents have materials that can be diverted through the green bin or blue box programs.

# **Garbage Bag Tags**

- Residents that are over the 4 bag limit must affix a pre-purchased garbage bag tag to any additional bags over the limit. Tags cost \$12.50/sheet of 5 tags. Bag tags can be purchased at any Town of Whitby facility or online at whitby.ca/BagTags.
- Residents who are unable to meet the bag limit restrictions due to a medical condition may qualify for Whitby's Special Consideration Program. Learn more at whitby.ca/BagTags.







# **Large Item Special Collections**

#### **Bulky and Metal Collection**

#### \$25 collection fee for up to 12 large items

- Items include: box springs, mattresses, bed frames, sofas, appliances, barbecues, furniture, sporting equipment, artificial Christmas trees. Construction and renovation waste will not be collected.
- Special Collection payments can be made by Mastercard® or Visa® online at the time of booking or in person at Town Hall.
- Book online at whitby.ca/Waste or by calling 905-668-3437, Monday to Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

#### Electronic Waste and Porcelain Collection is FREE

Items include: computer peripherals (mouse, modem, keyboard, hard drive), TVs, printers, audio equipment, toilets (tanks must be separated from toilet bowls before collection day). These items will be collected free of charge, but must also be booked in advance online at whitby.ca/Waste or by calling 905-668-3437, Monday to Friday 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.
