



Community Connection 2020 Summer Camp Employment Program

Community Connection is currently accepting resumes for the following summer employment positions: Camp Director, Assistant Camp Director and Counsellor in Training (CIT) Leader, as well as Counsellors for Day Camp, Sports Camp, Kinder Camp (ages 4-5 yrs.), Young Chefs' Camp (must have cooking experience), and Arts/Crafts Camp (must have a background in arts/crafts). Community Connection is a non-profit organization that offers affordable recreation programs in local schools. Individuals applying for this position would be hired by Community Connection to run summer camp programs at John Dryden P.S and Ormiston P.S. This is separate from Town of Whitby camp employment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants **must** be a minimum of 16 years of age;
- Applicants **must** have current Basic First Aid and CPR "B" or CPR "C" certifications (proof will be required at the interview stage);
- Applicants **must** have leadership experience and/or completion of the Counsellor in Training (C.I.T.) Program (proof will be required at the camp training stage);
- Applicants **must** be available to attend an interview, if invited, during the Family Day weekend, February 14 or 15, 2020;
- Applicants that are selected **must** be available for camp training on June 6, 2020 and for the duration of the contract period, from June 26, 2020 to August 21, 2020.

Resumes will be matched with opportunities, based on skills, experience and/or course of study.

Application Process:

- Applications/Resumes **must** indicate current level of education;
- Applications/Resumes **must** indicate current and/or future program of study;
- Applications/Resumes **must** be received by Community Connection no later than Sunday, February 2, 2020;
- Please indicate: "Camp Director", and/or "CIT Leader", and/or "Assistant Director", and/or "Day Camp Counsellor" and/or "Arts & Crafts Camp Counsellor" and/or "Young Chefs' Counsellor" and/or "Kinder Camp Counsellor" and/or "Sports Camp Counsellor" in the Subject Line of your e-mail Application and Cover Letter;
- Selected applicants will be required to undergo pre-employment assessments and will be advised accordingly.

Please note: These are **not** positions which fall within the Town of Whitby Program.
