



Town of Whitby Application for a Street Closure for a Street Dance

Street closures for a street dance will only be considered for cul-de-sacs, small crescents and dead-end streets and is only for neighbourhood events.

This application must be submitted **at least** 60 business days prior to the event.

Every resident on the street must be notified, in writing, of the proposed street closure and the application must be signed by at least 90% of the residents.

The applicant must provide public liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$2,000,000.00. Such insurance policy shall be in the name of the applicant and shall name the Town of Whitby as an additional insured and shall be provided on the form supplied by the Town. The Certificate of Insurance must be submitted with the application.

Note: The Town reserves the right to set higher insurance limits. If inflatable play structures are being used for the street dance/party, \$5,000,000.00 insurance is required.

As well, a Hold Harmless Agreement, also provided by the Town, shall be signed by the applicant and witness accordingly. No alterations to the Hold Harmless Agreement will be accepted. All completed documents must be submitted to the Office of the Town Clerk for consideration.
