Re: Delegation of Mayor's powers re organizational structure, employment matters, and chief administrative officer

The Mayor hereby delegates to the Chief Administrative Officer in accordance with subsection 284.13 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 (the "Act") and section 6 of O. Regulation 530/22:

- the Mayor's powers under subsection 284.6 (1) of the Act to determine the organizational structure, which shall be exercised in accordance with the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) Appointment and Duties, Roles and Responsibilities By-law #7274-17, noting that this by-law may be repealed and replaced or amended from time to time by Council; and,
- the Mayor's powers under subsection 284.6 (2) of the Act to hire, dismiss, or exercise any
 other prescribed employment powers, which shall be exercised in accordance with the Chief
 Administrative Officer (CAO) Appointment and Duties, Roles and Responsibilities By-law
 #7274-17, noting that this by-law may be repealed and replaced or amended from time to time
 by Council.

The Mayor hereby delegates to Council in accordance with subsection 284.13 (1) of the Municipal Act, 2001 (the "Act") and section 6 of O. Regulation 530/22:

- the Mayor's powers under section 284.5 of the Act to assign the powers of the Chief Administrative Officer, which Council has provided for through the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) Appointment and Duties, Roles and Responsibilities By-law #7274-17, noting that this by-law may be repealed and replaced or amended from time to time by Council; and,
- the Mayor's power under section 284.5 of the Act to appoint a Chief Administrative Officer, and as a transitional matter, the dismissal or the revocation of the Chief Administrative Officer's appointment under subsection 284.15 (1) of the Act.
