5. A vehicle inspection is required prior to issuing a limousine owner licence. Please call 905.430.4345 to schedule an appointment for a limousine inspection once you have all of the required documents.
6. The following documents must be submitted with the application:
 - a. Proof of current vehicle registration.
 - b. For vehicles 3 or more years old, current MTO Safety Standard Certificate (or Commercial Safety for Accessible Vehicles).
 - c. Valid Automobile Liability Certificate of Insurance (minimum \$2,000,000).
7. A Limousine Owner's Licence is valid for 1 year.
