**Non-priority locations are subject to approval and discretion of the Supervisor of Parks Development or delegate, to ensure the proposed locations are appropriate. The fees for non-priority locations reflect the full cost and additional staff time to coordinate and install the alternative locations.

Please use the box below to enter the wording you would like on the plaque, indicate upper- and lower-case letters where desired and carefully check spelling and dates. Bench and Tree plaques are 4 x 8 inches. Commemorative tree plaques should include the tree species at the top of the plaque (common and scientific name, see ex. 4 on p. 3). The maximum length of text is 7 lines with approximately 35 characters per line, including spaces. The minimum text height size is 8mm (measured using capital letter H), Arial font only, and text must be mixed case not all capitals. Graphic clip art may be incorporated into the plaque formatting but will reduce lines and/or characters. Please refer to examples on the next page.
