Manager's Report

- Summer in Review Summer Student Lindsay Smith finished her summer term with 55+ on August 29. She created and ran 13 events with 275 people registered.
- Fall 2025 We have partnered with Durham College and are welcoming 2 students from the Fitness and Health Promotion program this Fall. Students come for placement every Monday and Tuesday; they will alternate 7 weeks at 55+ and 7 weeks at the Civic Recreation Complex with Fitness & Aquatics. Arshpreet will be with us for 7 weeks, then Dilpreet will join us on October 27. They will be shadowing and leading parts of some group fitness classes. Arshpreet is offering 4 x 30-minute personal wellness sessions on Tuesday afternoons and would like to invite two members from the Committee (or their family member). Erica will connect with David Poirier and Susan Lythgoe to confirm details (Lynda will be back-up).
- Seniors Community Grant Mindful Aging Project \$13,300 received in funding from the Seniors Community Grant Program Partnering with Ontario Shores to offer the Mindful Aging Project, a series of 4 wellness workshops focussed on mental health for those 55+ Themes include supporting mental well-being through art and creativity, a dementia overview (how to recognize and support for caregivers), selfcare and emotional wellness. The Committee provided input to the final workshop theme and felt Mindfulness and Meditation would be the best workshop to close out the series.
