Community Connection is currently accepting resumes for the position of Day Camp Counsellor and Kinder Camp Counsellor for our John Dryden P.S., 40 Rolling Acres Drive, Whitby, location. Community Connection is an organization that offers affordable evening recreation and leisure programs and summer camps in local schools. Individuals applying for this position would be hired by Community Connection. This is separate from Town of Whitby camp employment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicants **must** be a minimum of 16 years of age;
- Applicants **must** have current Standard First Aid and CPR “C” certifications (proof will be required prior to the start of camp);
- Applicants **must** provide a valid Police Criminal Record Check to work with the Vulnerable Sector
- Applicants **must** have leadership or camp experience and/or completion of a Counsellor in Training (C.I.T.) Program (proof will be required at the interview stage);

Resumes will be matched with opportunities, based on skills, experience and/or course of study.

Application Process:

- Resumes **must** be received by Community Connection no later than Sunday January 12, 2026;
- Please include your education history
- In-person interviews will be held on Family Day weekend, Friday February 13 to Tuesday February 17, 2026;
- Applicants must be available to work from June 25 to August 21, Monday to Friday;
- Selected applicants will be required to undergo pre-employment assessments and will be advised accordingly.

Please note: These are **not** positions which fall within the Town of Whitby Camp Program.
