## Notice is hereby given to the Municipal Electors of the Town of Whitby

Nominations in the Town of Whitby will be accepted in-person or by an agent at the Office of the Town Clerk, 575 Rossland Road East, Whitby, between May 1, 2026 and August 20, 2026 during regular business hours and on Friday, August 21, 2026 (Nomination Day) between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. for the following elected offices for the Municipal Election to be held on **Monday, October 26, 2026**:

Offices for Election	Number to be Elected
Mayor	<b>One</b> to be elected by all electors in the Town of Whitby
Regional Councillor	<b>One</b> to be elected per Ward ( <b>Four total</b> ), by electors in their respective ward, in the Town of Whitby
Local/Ward Councillor	<b>One</b> to be elected per Ward ( <b>Four total</b> ), by electors in their respective ward, in the Town of Whitby
Trustee, Durham District School Board	<b>Three</b> to be elected by all English public school electors in the Town of Whitby
Trustee, Durham Catholic District School Board	<b>Two</b> to be elected by all English catholic school electors in the Town of Whitby
Conseiller(ere), Conseil scolaire Viamonde	<b>One</b> to be elected by all French public school electors in the Region of Durham, the Counties of Haliburton, Northumberland and Peterborough, and the Cities of Kawartha Lakes, Peterborough and Quinte West*
Conseiller(ere), Conseil scolaire catholique MonAvenir	<b>One</b> to be elected by all French catholic school electors in the Region of Durham, the Counties of Northumberland and Peterborough, and the Cities of Kawartha Lakes, Peterborough and Quinte West*

\* Nominations will be received in Legislative Services, City of Oshawa, 50 Centre Street South, Oshawa, Ontario

### Candidates

Candidates are encouraged to book an appointment to file their nomination to ensure timely service. No person who proposes to be a candidate may solicit or accept contributions for election purposes or incur campaign expenses until a nomination paper has been filed.

### Third Party Advertisers

A third party advertisement is an advertisement in any broadcast, print, electronic or other medium that promotes, supports or opposes a candidate. Third party advertising is separate from any candidate's

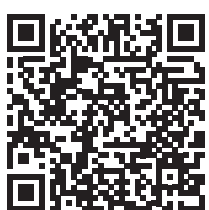
campaign and must be done independently from a candidate. Third party advertising is a way for those outside of a candidate's campaign to express support of or opposition to candidates and to try to persuade voters to vote in a certain way.

Only those who have registered can incur expenses on third party advertising. An individual, corporation or trade union that meets the eligibility requirements may register as a third party advertiser with the Town Clerk between May 1, 2026 and October 23, 2026.
